GWACs

Governmentwide Acquisition Contracts (GWACs) are task order or delivery order contracts for information technology (IT). These contract vehicles provide high quality, state-of-the-

art, total integrated solutions for your IT requirements.

GWACs have competition requirements that differ from MAS contracts and a delegation of authority is required prior to their use. Each GWAC is operated by an executive agent designated by the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) pursuant to section 5112(e) of the Clinger-Cohen Act. GSA has established three GWAC Centers: Enterprise GWAC Center, IT GWAC Center, and the Small Business GWAC Center.
